Hillet Botha holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Pretoria, South Africa; an Accompanist and Teacher’s Diploma from the University of South Africa; and a Master of Music degree from the New England Conservatory in Boston, Massachusetts.

She started piano at the age of eight under the guidance of Lorraine Joubert and later studied under Professor Joseph Stanford at the University of Pretoria.

Hillet performed extensively in South Africa as soloist, accompanist and chamber music member with various performances on national television and radio.

In 1997, Hillet moved to the US and studied piano performance under Jacob Maxin at the New England Conservatory. While in Boston, she performed at various festivals, concerts and master classes at the New England Conservatory.

Since moving to California in 2007, Hillet has been performing as soloist and accompanist for instrumentalists and vocalists, notably at First Presbyterian Church in Salinas and Church in the Forest in Pebble Beach.

Hillet lives in Carmel with her husband and three children.


