Dear Friends,

On Friday, June 2, our former pastor, Harold Englund, died. Recently in declining health, Harold had been blessed by a clear awareness that his time was drawing short. His beloved wife and partner in ministry, Enid, shared with me that, in his final hours, she told him that it was “okay to go, that he had lived a long and productive life,” and that now it was time to go to the Lord.

What a productive life—a harvest for the Lord! Harold led with love and intellect as a pastor, scholar, but especially friend. That commitment made him hesitate, before he accepted Church in the Forest’s offer to “fill in” between pastors, as Lamont Wiltsee left and before a new search found us Bill Rolland. Harold was concerned to not be disruptive to the ministry of his successors at his old parish, Carmel Presbyterian, by taking a position so close by.

But, we somehow persuaded Harold and Enid—they “filled in” for five years! Enid thinks our secret was, “there weren’t those night meetings that tire ministers out!”


Despite health challenges, Harold and Enid shared each night a time of biblical reflection and prayer. Enid said that, when Harold prayed, it was as though he were younger, as he remembered names and spoke with his old eloquence in prayer to the Lord.

Indeed, when we are connected to God, we are at our best! We’ll explore that idea this Sunday in worship, when I preach on Genesis 1–2.
