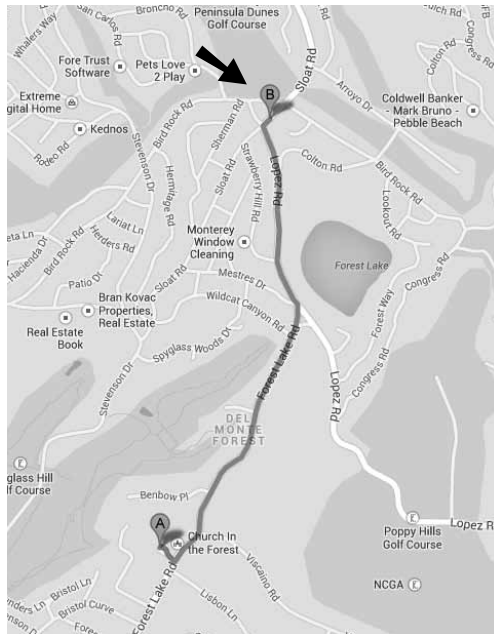
Please take note of these excellent learning opportunities offered by the Church in the Forest.

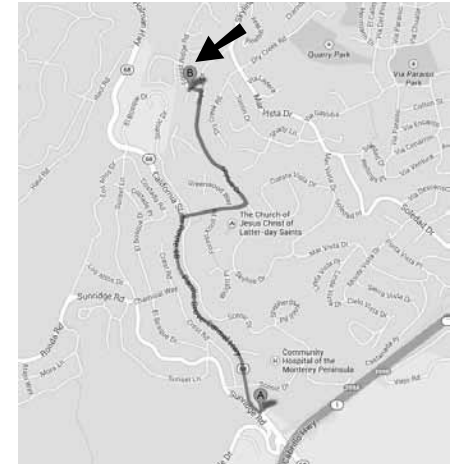
