Podcasts Now Available

If you haven't looked at the Church in the Forest website in a while, please do. You may be pleasantly surprised.


For example, we now have the ability to make podcasts available to you. What is a podcast? It's a recording of an entire Sunday service. And it's ready for listening at 1:00 pm on the day of the service.

To hear the podcast, log onto the Church in the Forest website: (www.churchintheforest.org) and click on WORSHIP SERVICE PODCAST from the Home Page. Make sure your computer speakers are ON.

The next screen you will see is the podcast screen. On the left you will see Sunday Service. All the way over on the right you will see the date (in this case, March 25, 2012). Click on the PLAY button just to the right of the date. You'll hear the beginning of the service right away. If you want to skip the introductory part of the service and go directly to the sermon, place your cursor on the gray elapsed time rectangular box, left click and hold the left-button down and use your mouse to slide the cursor to the right until you get to the sermon.
