Dear members and friends,


A number of Easters ago, I preached a sermon borrowing the title from a sermon preached by my mentor and colleague, Dr. Donald M. Miesel. It was entitled, "Between a Rock and a Hard Place." Don had found himself in that state, between a rock and a hard place in that his wife Eleanor had become very sick with a cancer of the inner ear, which had gone undiagnosed for some months, resulting in the disease taking a stranglehold of her, severely disfiguring her face. While she did live for a number of years, the living was a huge trial in and of itself.

For the Miesel family, that phrase described their real life situation. But for Don and for Ely, there was a strength that came into play, a song that could not be gagged, and a saving force that could not be prevented from doing its work.

For them, in a very pragmatic and down-to-earth way, that hard place had pointed them and the family to a place where they could truly testify that even there: "The Lord is my strength and my song, and has become my salvation." It was for those of us watching and loving them, a real story of triumph. A conviction beyond reason one could call it! And in reality that is what the Easter message is at its heart. So, if you find yourself between a rock and a hard place, may the resurrected Christ draw near and encourage your heart and enliven your spirit.
