Parking at Church in the Forest

Many of our congregation are concerned about parking at Church in the Forest (CitF). Their concern stems from the fact that Sunday parking near the Church is often not available, and parking along the roads near the Church has its own problems such as safety, distance from the Church, and reaction of the neighborhood to having cars parked near homes.

The CitF ministerial staff and the Church Board have decided to implement a trial program to see if the parking problem could be alleviated. Beginning Sunday, June 23, 2013, we will have valet parking available. If you wish to avail yourself of this service, please drive to the front of the Church where you will be met by a valet. Be sure you leave your car key with him/her. You will be given a claim check which you will present to the valet to have your car retrieved.

This service will be provided at no cost to you. This includes tips. Tips will be covered by the Church as part of the valet parking contract.

For those who wish to park their own car, the usual areas will still be available.

The intent is to run this program for a three-month period and then assess how well it works, and how many people use it. Once such data are collected, the Church Board will then decide if the program should be continued.

Once you have had a chance to use the valet parking service, please direct any comments concerning it to Carol Sullivan. Contact her, too, if you have any questions. **Remember: The new service begins Sunday, June 23, 2013.**
