Today celebrates the Italian genius for music. Notice the names of the composers; they all end in “i,” pronounced eeeeeeeee, although not all of them were that high-strung.

A professional violinist and composition teacher as well, he had the misfortune to be on the scene when Mussolini came to power. Some idiots thought it was impossible to separate his compositions from that bully, although in fact he was totally non-political and just wanted to be left alone to pursue his music. (I mean, of course, no disrespect for idiots.) Reviews, even a few years ago, sniffed that his music is strident, vulgar, derivative, lacking a distinctive, personal style, and tainted by his support of Mussolini.

Later, he shaved his head and demanded that all music critics be taken out and shot.
