“Gifted, exceptionally lazy, and frequently absent” is how the records of the Paris Conservatoire characterize Erik Satie. I think Labor Day would have pleased him, and the irony of its name would surely have appealed to his satirical instincts.

Bureaucratically impaired, he was a thorn in the side of the establishment, and was once fined heavily and sentenced to eight days in jail for sending a rude postcard to a critic. (True. Check it out in *Grove’s Dictionary of Music and Musicians*) The jail sentence was suspended on appeal, probably because, although an English translation of the postcard message is terrifically insulting (not to mention anatomically impossible), yet the grammar of the original is impeccable and carries an agreeable clarity to the finely tuned ear of a French person.
