Dear Members and Friends,

Well, we've taken another leap of faith as we jump, slide, crawl or race into the Advent Season. It is a time of trying to make sense of all that is going on around us while waiting for the arrival of the Divine in our lives.

Some years ago I heard about a Presbyterian minister who, during the worship service on the First Sunday in Advent, had just begun his sermon when suddenly he said to the congregation: "You carry on. I will be back." With no word of explanation, he walked out of the church, got into his car and drove away.

Stunned, the worshippers just sat there until one of the elders got up and led the group in singing some hymns, offered some prayers, and being a good Scottish Presbyterian, took up the offering, then awkwardly finished the service and dismissed the shocked congregation.

It wasn't that the pastor had "flipped out" or had "lost it" and wanted to go home and crawl under the bed with shame or distress. No, nothing like that.

He was trying to make a point, reminding his congregation that the whole point of Advent is a reminder of the constant, watchful carrying on in which the church is engaged until the fullness of God's rule comes with Jesus' return.

The promise to us is that our waiting is not in vain. We may wonder, as did that minister's congregation, what's going on, but we can trust that God, in Jesus Christ, will be back!

HAVE A BLESSED ADVENT SEASON!

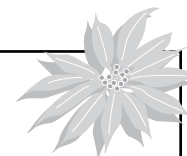
