Do you want to experience what Easter means—especially for your life? **Join us before Easter, for Holy Week worship, Thursday and Friday at 6 PM.** Here, in the quiet spaces of our chapel, prayers, music and the Word, you will re-experience Christ's final days and their reverberations in your life and world. Then you will know what Easter means—what Easter overcomes!

To help you start, I encourage you to watch this powerful video, a brief reflection on the dark powers of Friday that Christ overcomes. Acclaimed and beloved by millions, this sermon is by the Rev.
