
Dear Friends,

We are delighted to welcome back Emi Saeki to CitF! This Tokyo-born, versatile artist is a professional organist, clavichordist, accompanist, and composer. Her music repertoire spans Renaissance to Contemporary and specializes in Japanese and Dutch music. She has given concerts in Germany, Austria, Czech Republic, Russia, and The Netherlands as well as Japan, and has appeared on local radio and TV shows in Japan. Her CDs include Piazzolla and Schunittke, Wien Hall Live, Composition for “Je bent de liefst” and Mozart’s “London Sketchbook.”

Emi conducted research on the Clavichord and wrote a thesis: “Jesuit missionaries and the clavichord in the Orient,” published by CLAVICHORD INTERNATIONAL. She won second prize award for her composition in the Yamaha International Contest held in Kyoto, Japan, in 1992, and in 1995 received a soloist diploma. She divides her time between Tokyo and Carmel. We hope to see and hear more of her this season.
