
Dear Members and Friends,

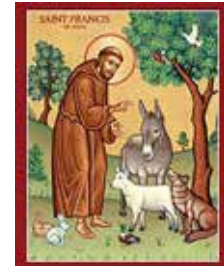
