Samuel Barber, trained early as a singer, always had a lyrical melodic bent, whether the style is post-Romantic or more modernistic. He made a statement in 1971 that could serve as his credo as a composer: "When I'm writing music for words, then I immerse myself in those words, and I let the music flow out of them... I write what I feel. I'm not a self-conscious composer... it is said that I have no style at all but that doesn't matter. I just go on doing, as they say, my thing. I believe this takes a certain courage".

The Hermit Songs were first performed by Leontyne Price, soprano, with the composer at the piano, at the Library of Congress, Washington, D.C., on October 30, 1953. They are settings of anonymous Irish texts of the 8th to 13th centuries written by monks and scholars, often on the margins of manuscripts they were copying or illuminating—perhaps not always meant to be seen by their Father Superiors. They are small poems, thoughts, or observations, some very short, and speak in a straightforward, droll, and often surprisingly modern terms of the simple life these men led, close to nature, to animals, and to God.

Report from the *Annual Congregational Meeting*

This past Sunday we held the *Annual Congregational Meeting* of the Church in the Forest, to adopt the budget for this year, 2014.

Church Treasurer, Peter McKee, reported that we are in a financially good position and have allocated \$26,000 for special needs in the community: *Stevenson School Scholarship Fund, Hospice Foundation, Monterey Food Bank, Boys and Girls Club of Monterey County* and *YWCA Safehouse Program*.

We are glad that Ken Feske's position will be funded for the coming year. He is already accomplishing what we, as a Church Board, felt was needed; taking the activities of the Church out to where our people are and especially to those who find it difficult to get to services. Both Charles and I are very appreciative of his assistance and friendship.

From all of us on staff, we thank you for your support and prayers and ask God to bless us as we worship and fellowship together.
