He has a son and a daughter, both musicians, both younger than he. His wife, Margie, is a superb cellist. He is a marathon runner, so he is often out of breath.

Some people have trouble telling the difference between a violin and a viola; Dave points out that a viola burns longer. You can see that he is an excellent teacher as well as a virtuoso violinist and violist, but he will deny he ever pointed out any such thing. I have known him for twenty-two years, and I can easily predict what he is going to deny.
